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

We focus on the following CVC words:

- ag: bag, flag, gag, rag, tag, wag
- am: ham, jam, ram, yam
- an: can, fan, man, pan, van
- ap: cap, gap, lap, nap, rap,
- at: bat, cat, hat, mat, rat

### Prep:

**Step 1:** Print all pages 4-8 in color or pages 9-13 in black and white.

**Step 2:** Laminate or put the colored pages in page protectors to make them reusable. Or use the black and white version as a worksheet.

**Step 3:** Gather whiteboard markers and an eraser for the laminated version or crayons for the worksheet.

### Directions:

**Step 1:** As you read the words, put your finger on the dot under the word to follow along. Say the name of the picture next to the sentence..

**Step 2:** You can either color the circles at the bottom of the page for each sentence you read or read all 6 sentences and then color a circle (you'd be reading each sentence six times total to fill in all of the circles)

**Step 3:** If you're doing the worksheet version, color the pictures.
