Step 3: Gather crayons/markers, paint and q-tips.

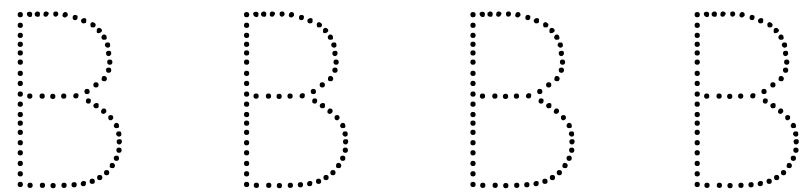
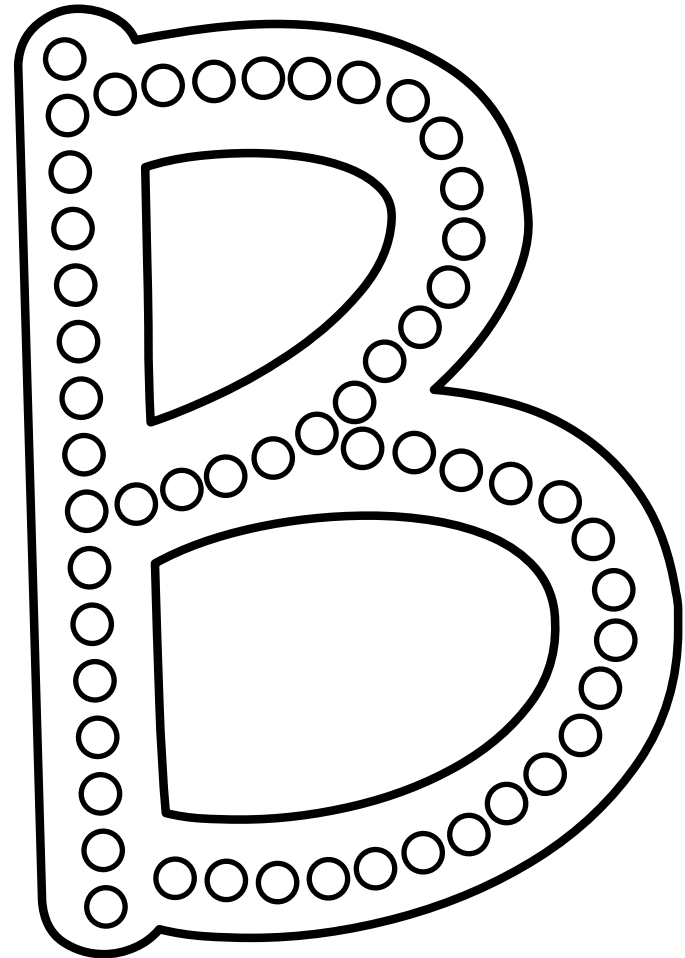
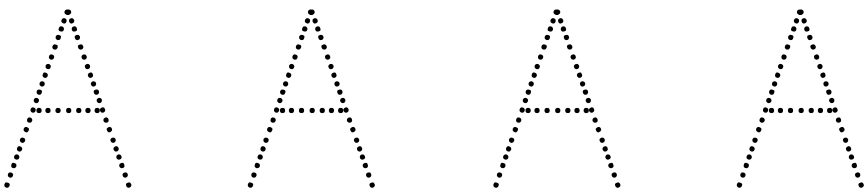
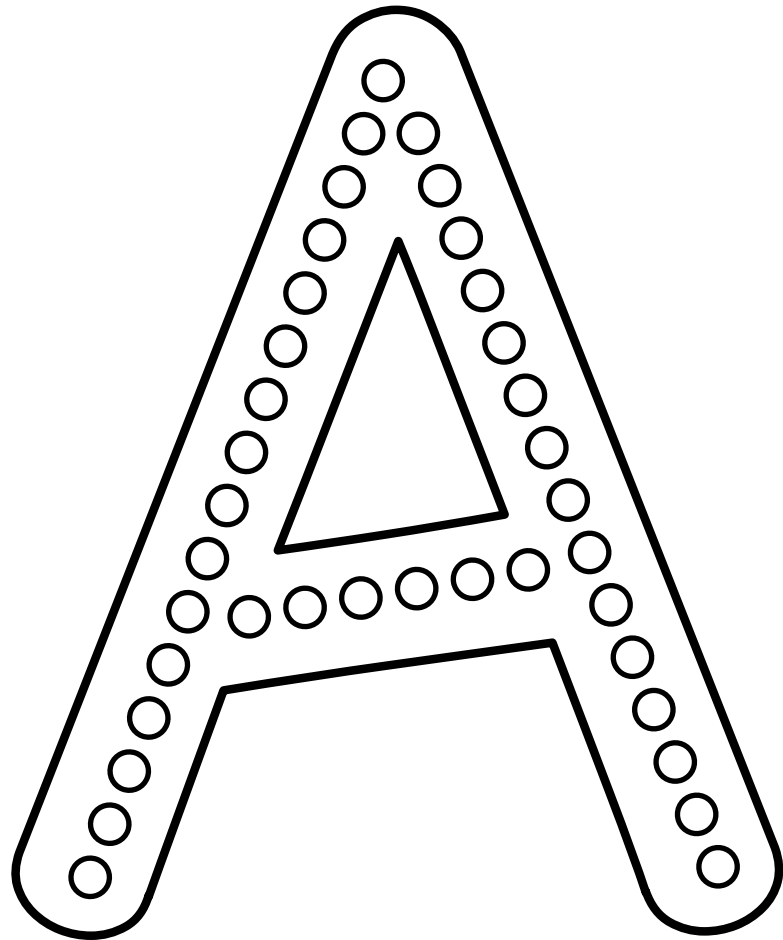

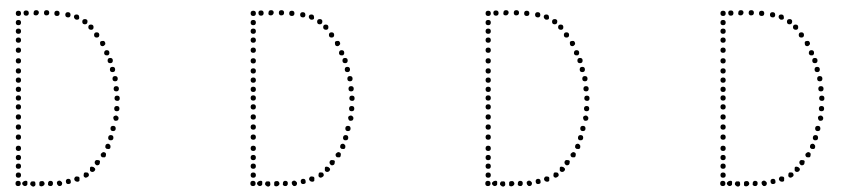
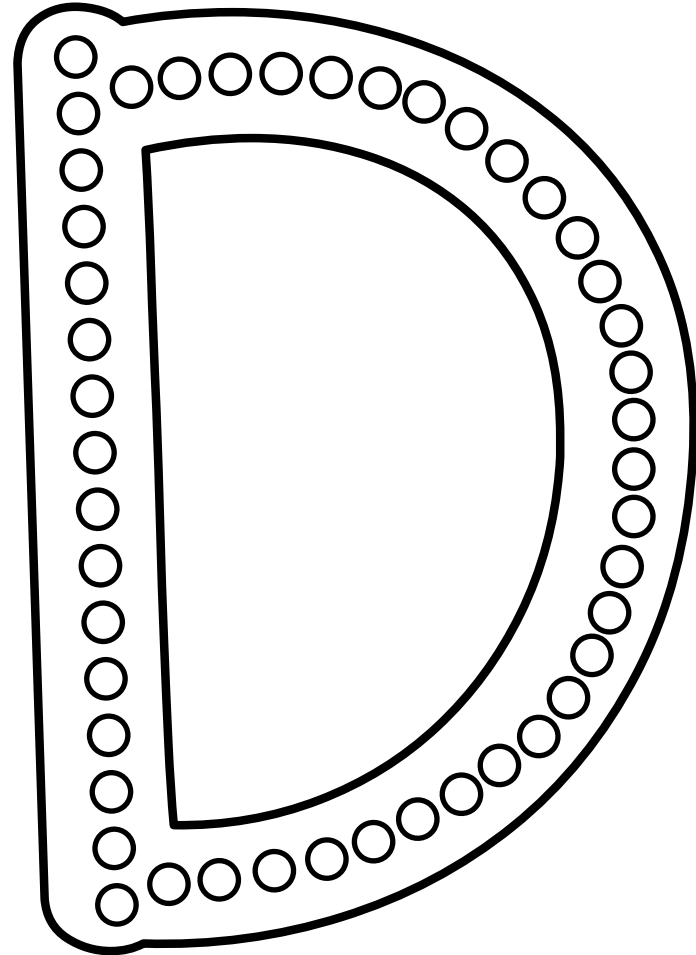
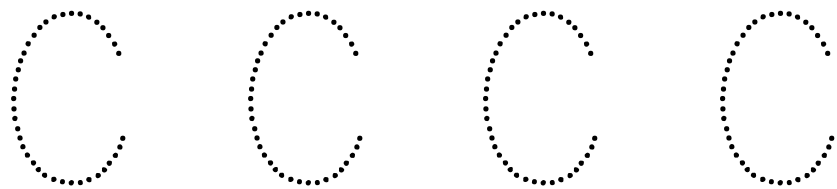
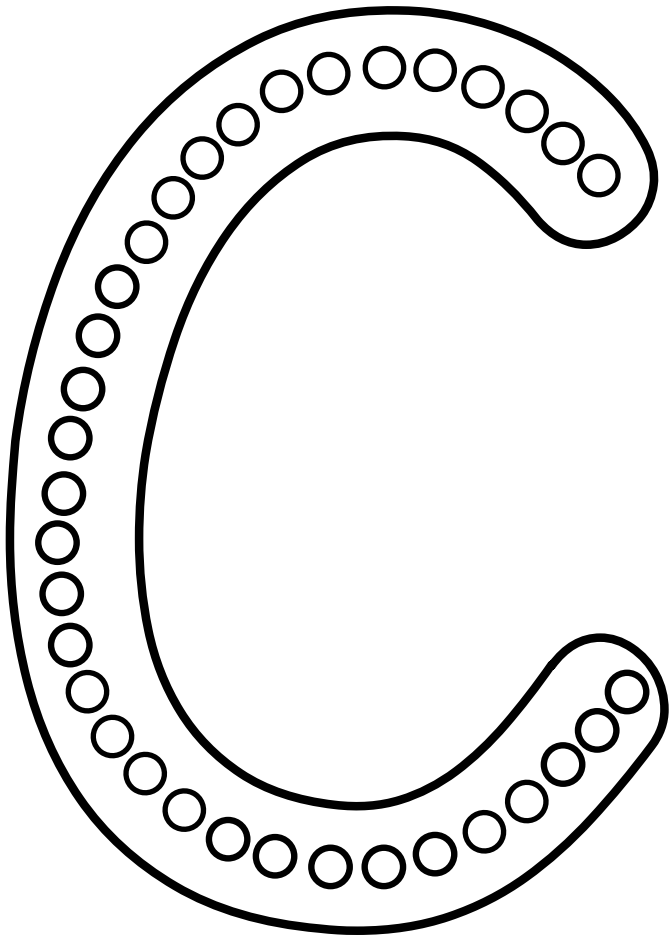
Step 1: Say the name of the letter. Dab a q-tip in [paint](#) and dab it in each circle around the letter.

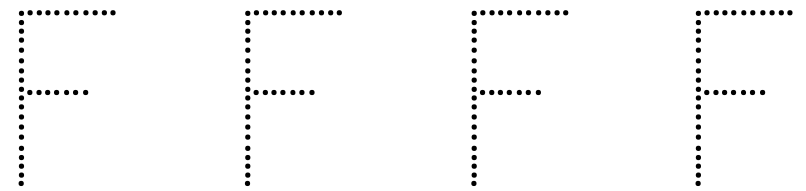
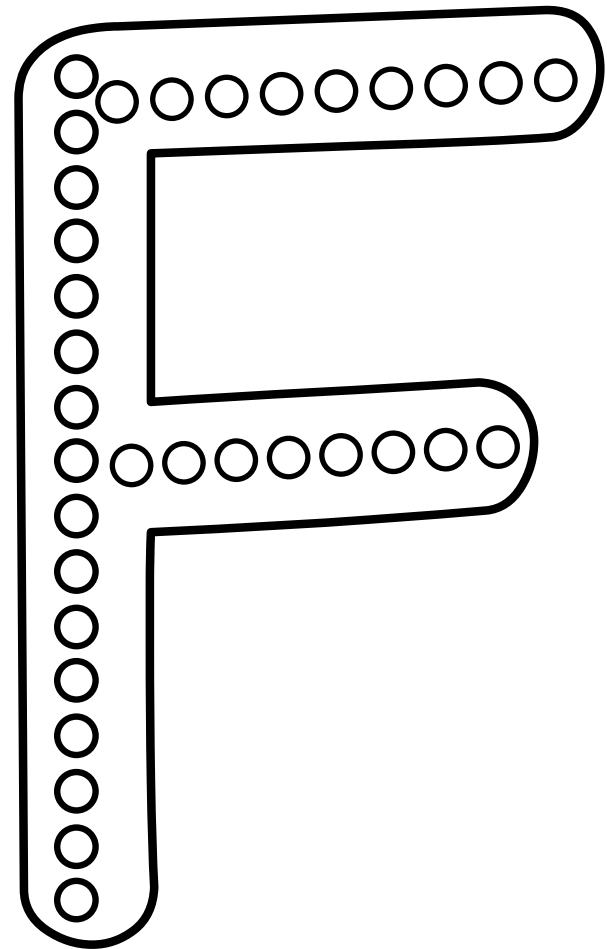
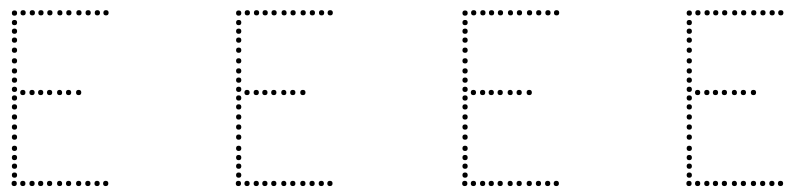
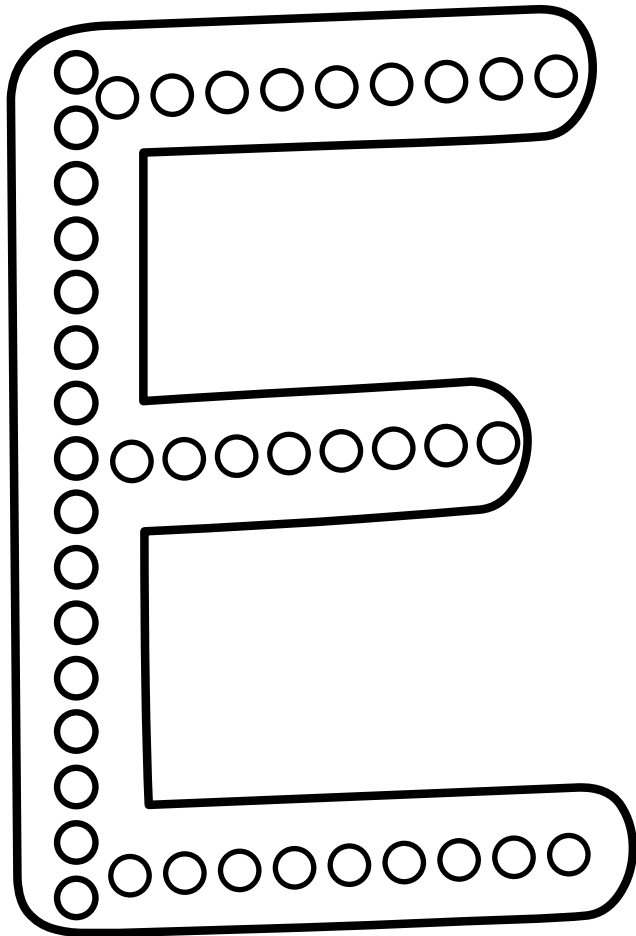
