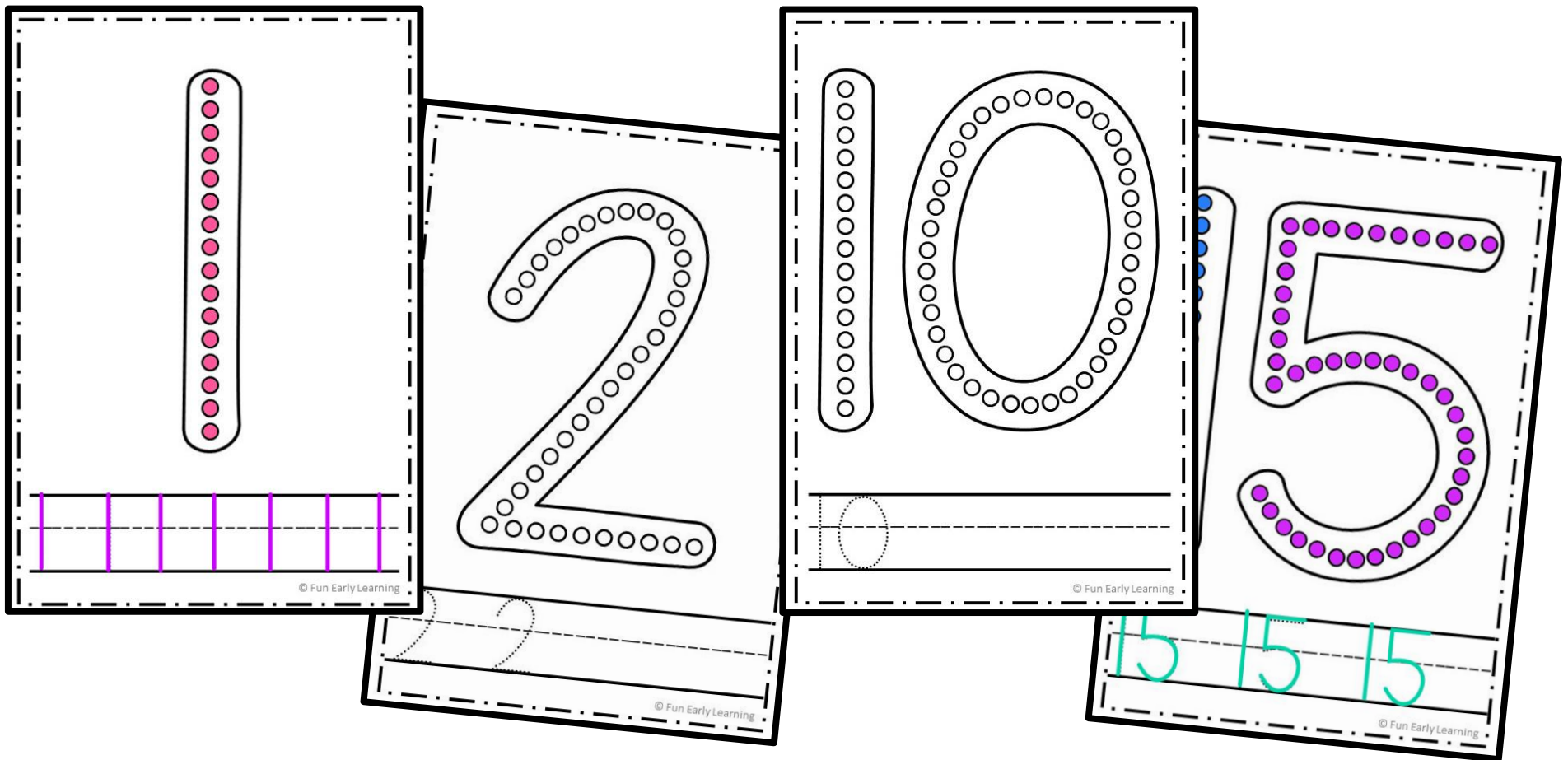




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
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## Dab-a-Dot Numbers

Dab-a-Dot Numbers Q-Tip Painting activity is a fun way to teach children number identification, number formation, and to build fine motor skills! Children will dip a q-tip in paint and dab a dot in the center of each dot on the page. They will then trace the numbers at the bottom and write their own on the remaining line.

### Prep:

**Step 1:** Print all pages 4-13 in black and white.

**Step 2:** Use the page as is for a worksheet or if you'd like to be able to reuse the pages, laminate them and use washable paints to wipe off at the end of each use. The page can be used whole or cut in half to separate the numbers.

**Step 3:** Gather crayons/markers, paint and q-tips.

### Directions:

**Step 1:** Say the name of the number. Dab a q-tip in paint and dab it in each circle around the number.

**Step 2:** Trace the numbers at the bottom of the page and then write your own on the remaining line.

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
