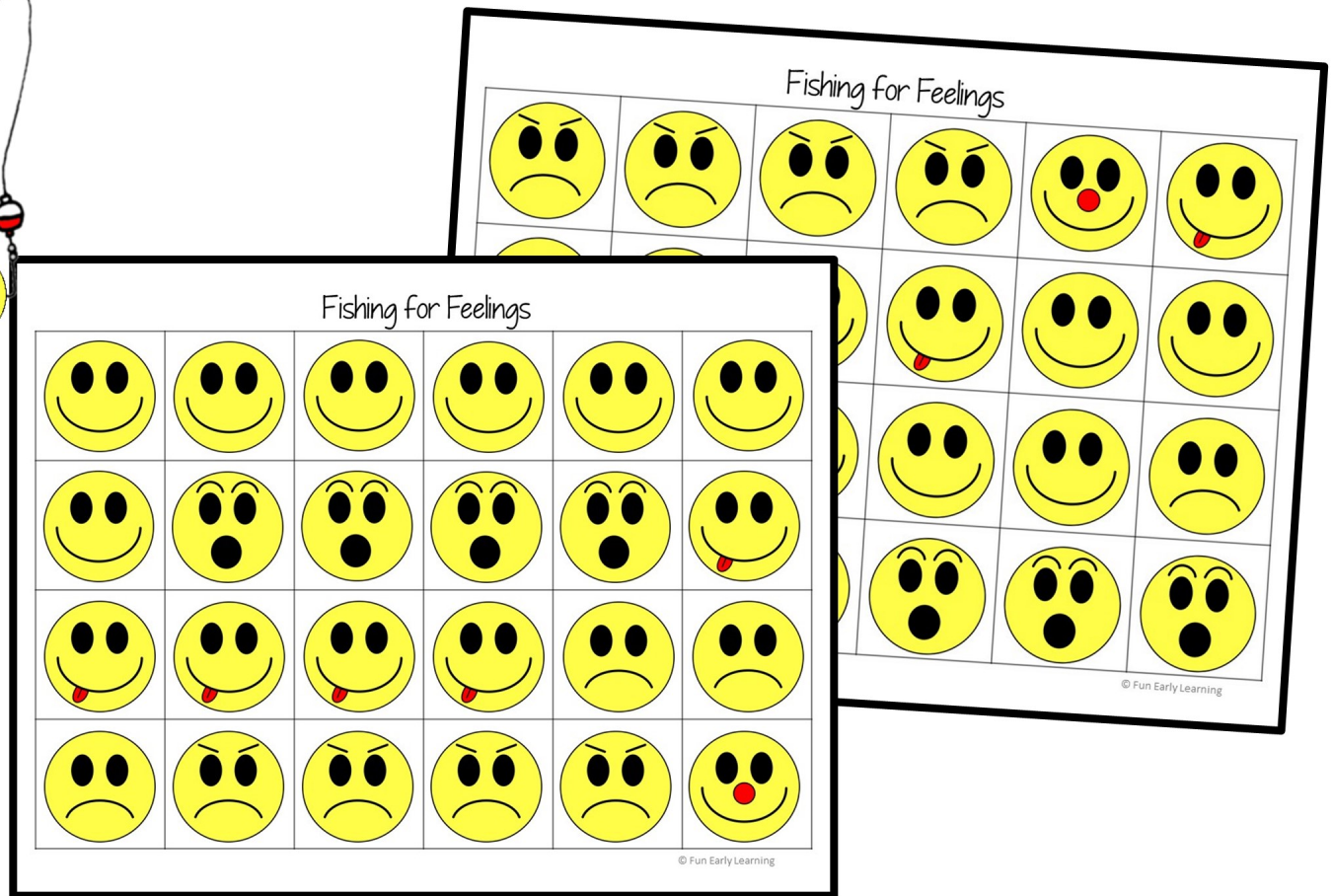
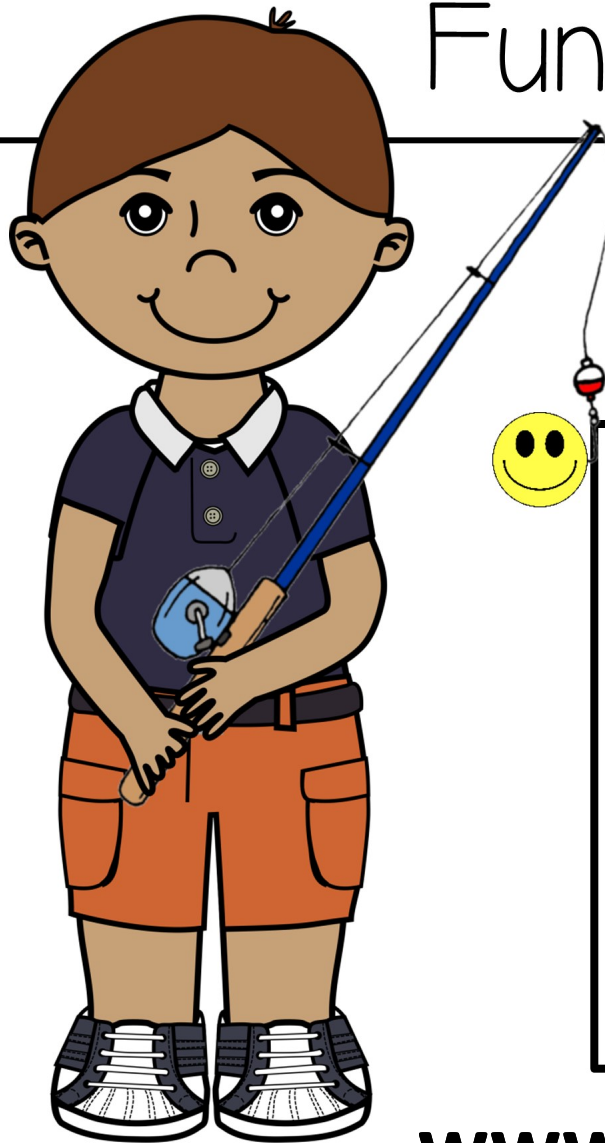


Fishing for Feelings

Prep:

Step 1: Print all pages in color. Pages 4 and 5 are the Feelings Mats.

Step 2: [Laminate](#) with [5 mil laminating pouches](#) for durability.

Step 3: Cut out the faces on page 6 with scissors or a [1.5" circle punch](#). Use a [hot glue gun](#) and [hot glue](#) to stick a [magnet](#) on the back of the face.

Step 4: Next make the fishing pole. Gather a wooden dowel, string, and [magnet with a hole](#) in the middle. Tape or glue one end of the string onto the tip/end of the dowel. Then tie the other end of the string onto the magnet.

Directions:

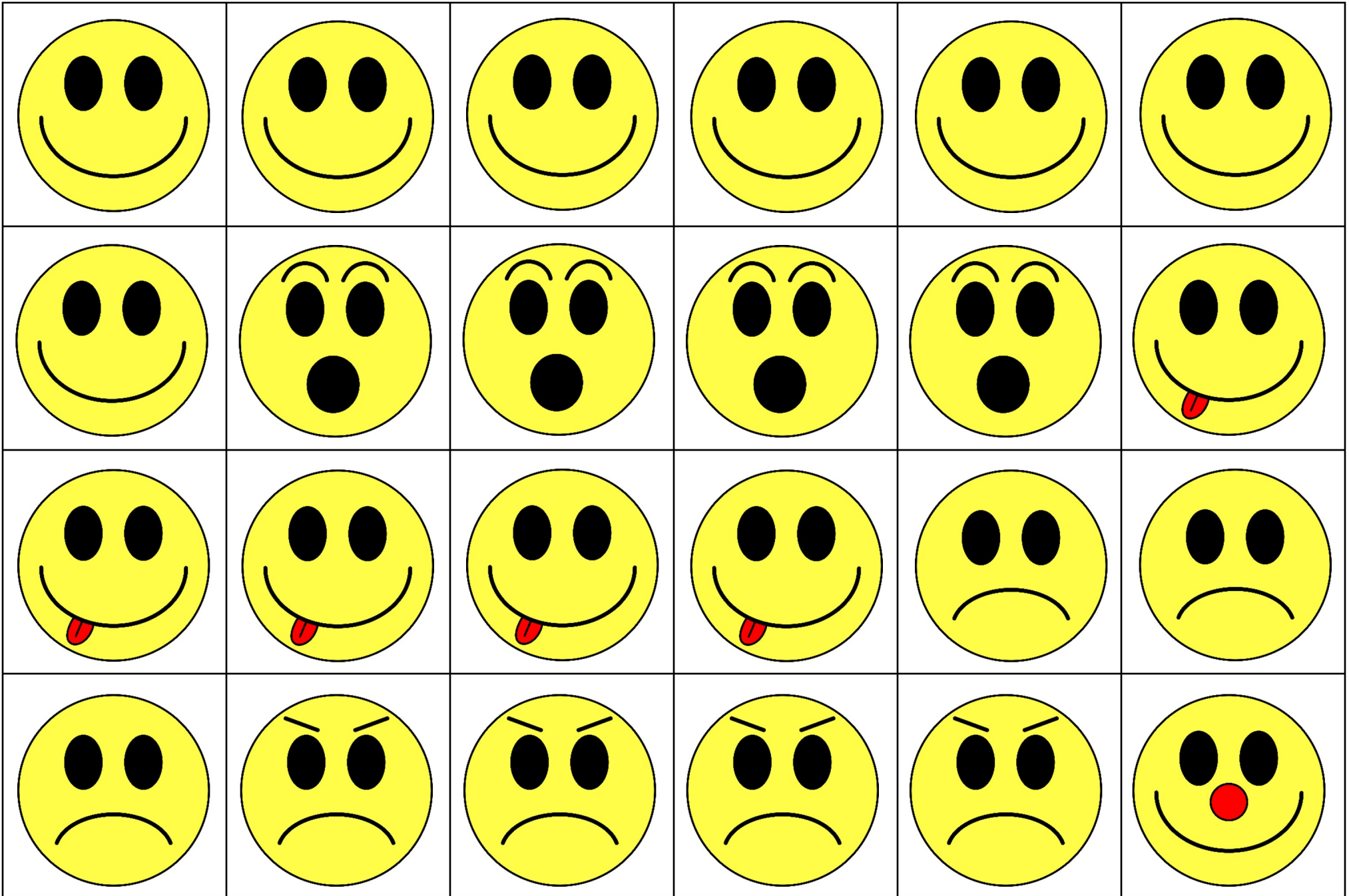
Step 1: Place either of the Feelings Mats that you'd like to complete on the table and put the faces you cut out into a dish.

Step 2: Use the fishing pole to fish in the bowl and catch a face. Once you've caught a face, match it to the Feelings Mat. What emotion did you match?
