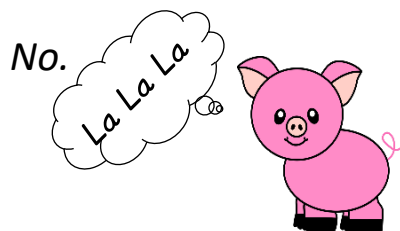

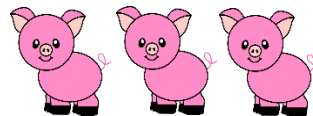

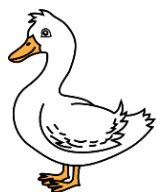

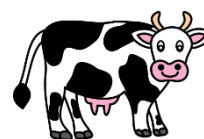

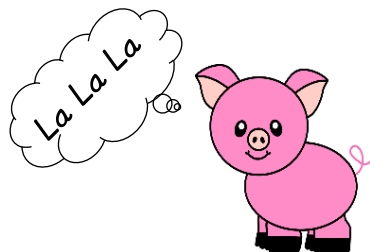

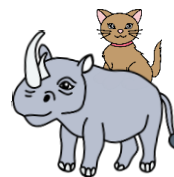

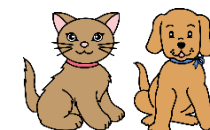

Because the dogs are chasing them.



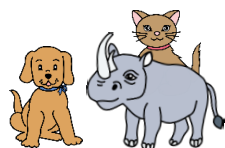

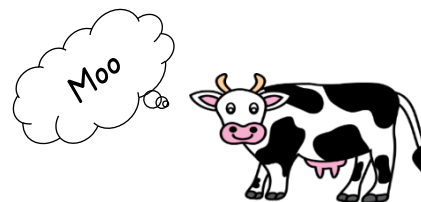
