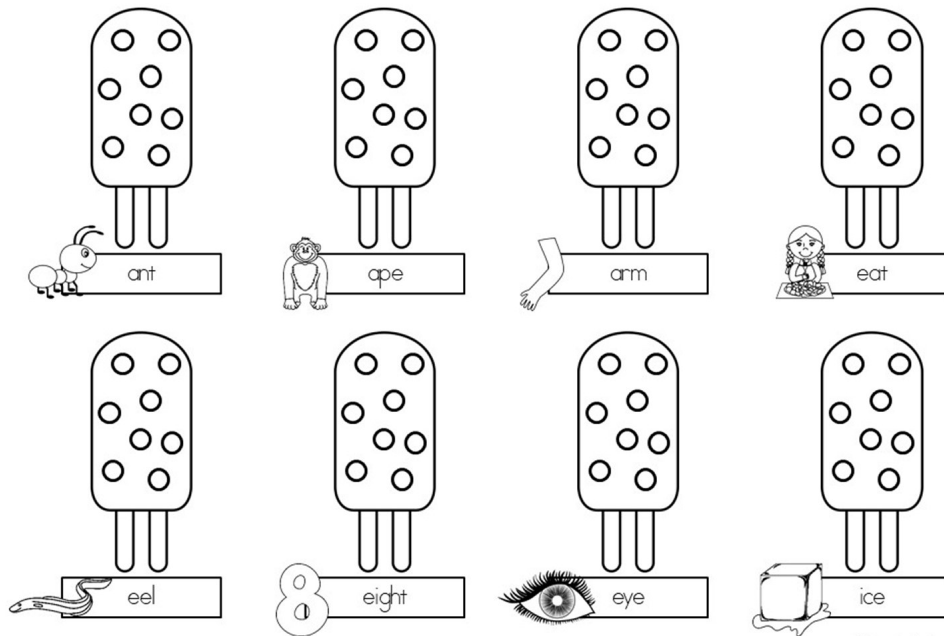

Painting Popsicles Articulation - VC

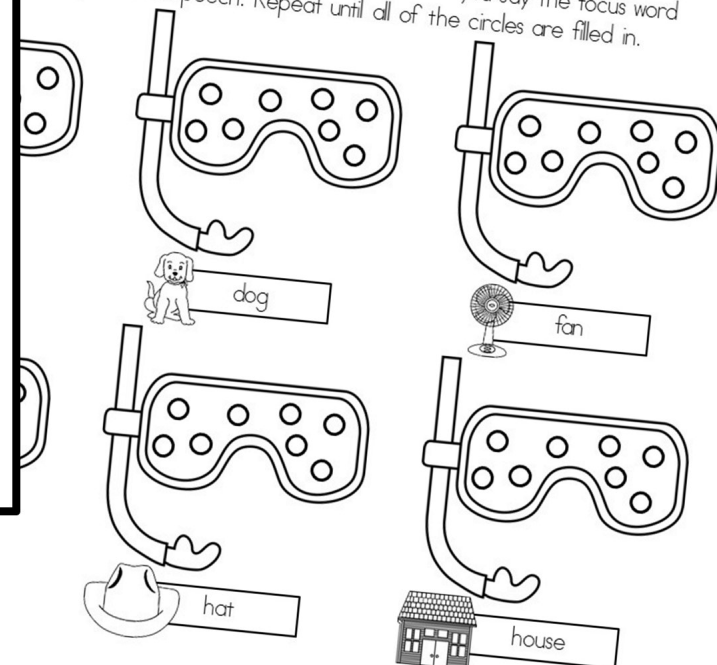

Step 1: Dip your q-tip in paint. Paint each circle in the picture with a q-tip after you say the focus word underneath it in your best speech.

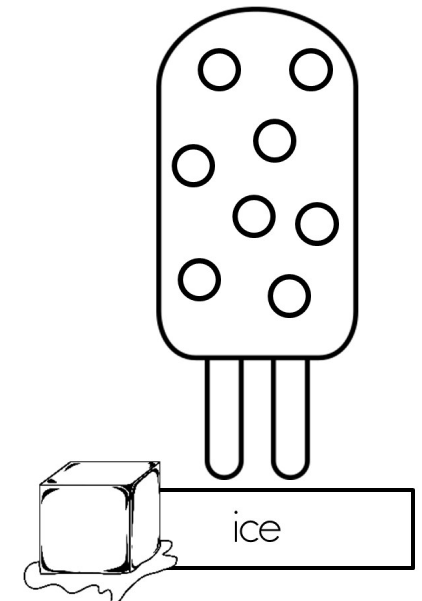
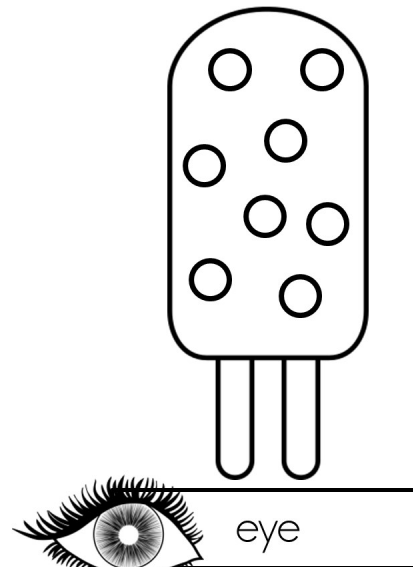
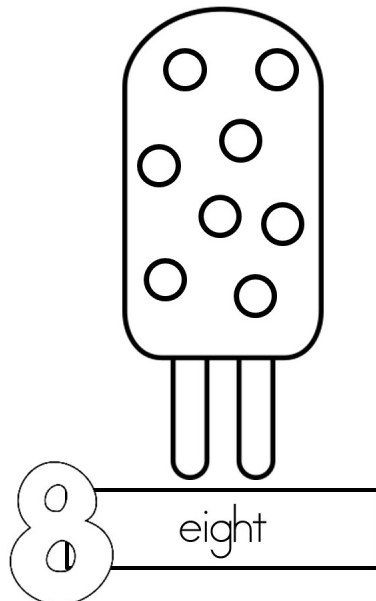
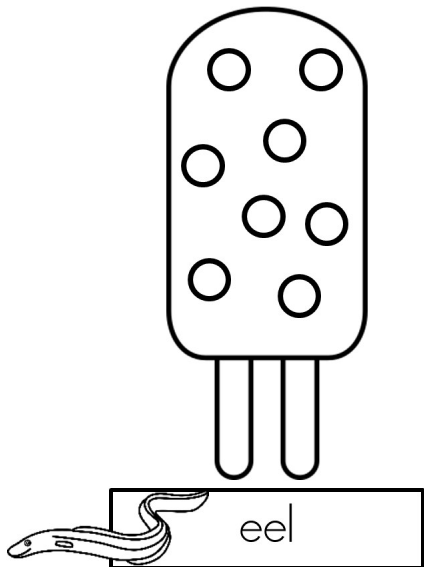
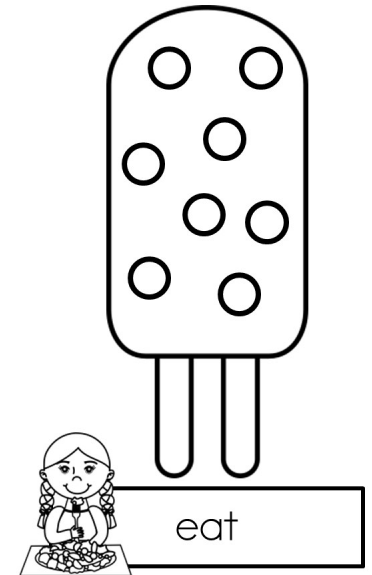
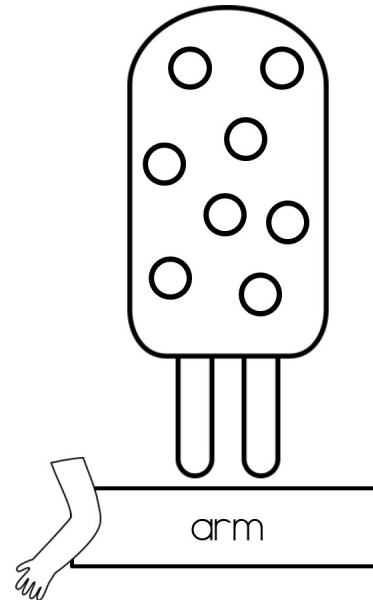
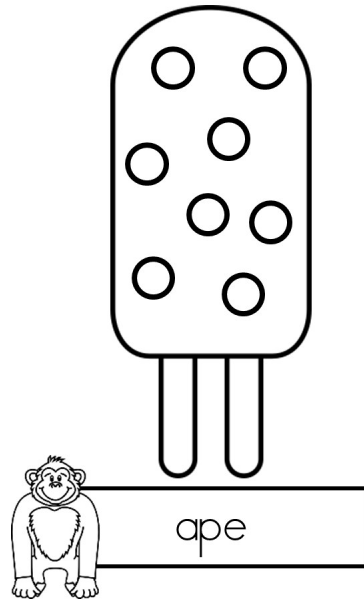
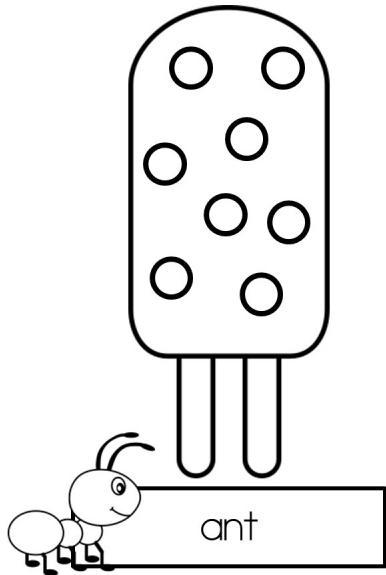
